I don't believe we had over 300 in the past. I am going to see her next week and offer to count the people at the meetings to see if we go over and if we do we will pay next year. Last year, the seed money donated by Pinellas County groups paid for all our expenses. Therefore, we have created a seed money flyer. GRATITUDE DINNER REPORT – Rosie W. - Thank you for giving me this challenging opportunity to be of service. Our sub-committees are actively working towards the execution of their respective tasks. I will be meeting with the Sysco Food representative to compare prices we have obtained at local food outlets, (i.e. Sam's, Costco). We will then decide the on the vendor best suited for price and delivery. Our F&B committee will be re-inspecting the Minnreg building this week to allow volunteers an opportunity to view the facility so they will be acclimated to their work areas prior to the dinner. Although I have been given a chair count, I would feel better if I did a personal count so as to have no last minute surprise. We are having a full committee meeting on the 26th but being in close contact with my co-chairs has allowed me to be assured they are well established in their undertakings. Statements by both the Chair and Alternate chairpersons stated that GSR's are needed from all groups. Many groups do not have GSR's and many do not attend the meetings. 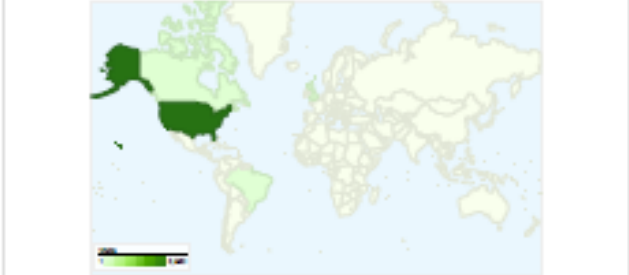

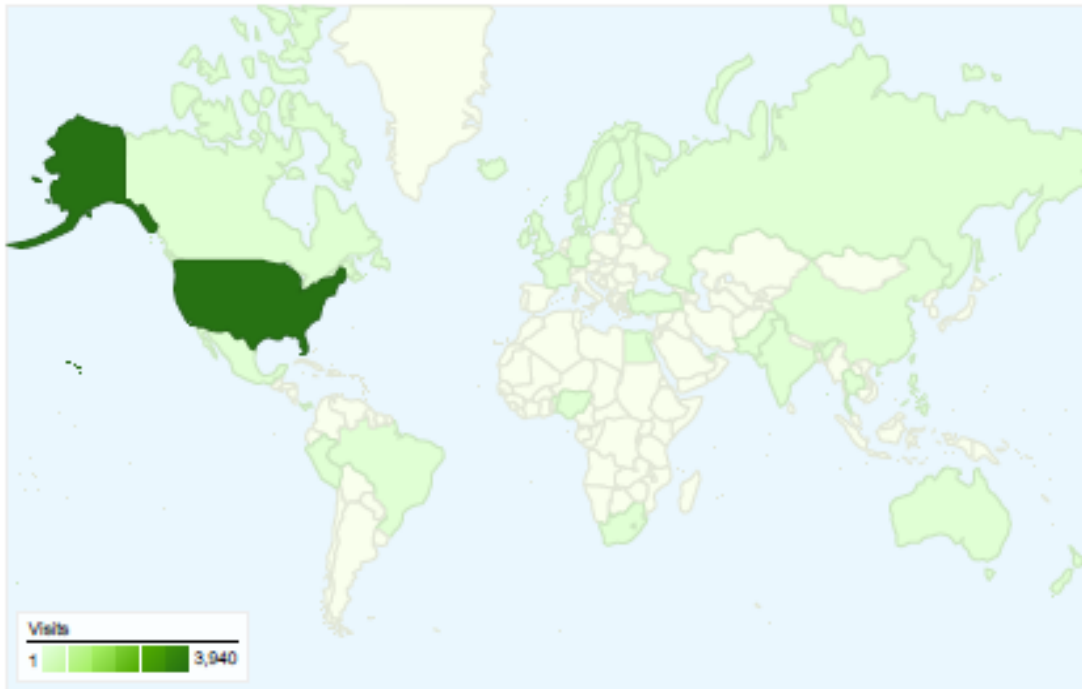
